Everyone is warmly welcomed to end this years Toller speciality with our unofficial dog show, which takes place at Lilltorpet, Falun.

This years Judges at the speciality is:

Yvonne Larsson Helene Björkman Mats Jonsson Annelie Karlsson Gunilla Skallman

Which class which judge will be judging will be appointed when entry is closed, so that the judges gets an even distribution of participants as possible.

Classes at the show:

Puppy class I (4-6 months)

Open to dogs that on the day they of the show have reached the age of 4 months but have yet not turned 6 months.

Puppy class II (6–9 months)

Open to dogs that on the day they of the show have reached the age of 6 months but have yet not turned 9 months.

Junior class (9–18 months)

Open to dogs that on the day they of the show have reached the age of 9 months but have yet not turned 18 months.

Intermediate class (15–24 months)

Open to dogs that on the day they of the show have reached the age of 15 months but have yet not turned 24 months.

Working class (15 months and older)

Open to dogs that on the day of the show have reached the age of 15 months and have hunting test merit, i.e. at least a Good (or 3rd prize taken before 2022 01 01) in the beginner class at hunting test, or a WCC from abroad hunting competitions.

Open class (15 months and older)

Open to dogs that have reached 15 months of age on the day of the show.

Champion class (15 months and older)

Open to dogs that have reached the age of 15 months on the day of the show and have been awarded a Swedish, Nordic or other SKK-approved national show championship or an FCI-confirmed international show championship.

Senior class (egenklass 1) (8 - 10 years of age)

Open to dogs that have reached the age of 8 years on the day of the show but have yet not turned 10.

Veteran class (10 years and older)

Open to dogs that have reached 10 years of age on the day of the show. Veterans are registered directly on the web page of the Speciality. See "Anmälan" and the link "Veteranklass"

Disqualifying faults class (egenklass 2) (from 4 months of age and older)

Open for dogs who for exampel as has too much white elsewhere than the breed standard prescribes, black in the coat, buff, bite defects, cryptorchid male, neutered male (regardless of the reason for castration) etc. The class has one female and one male dog class, and participating dogs are from 4 months of age and older.

Since we have a senior class and disqualifying faults class that is not available at official dog shows, these classes are named differently when you are going to enter your dog via SKK's internet Entry online.

Egenklass 1 = Senior class (8 - 10 years)

Egenklass 2 = Class for Disqualifying faults

Registration fee is paid at the same time as the registration is made through the web service. With credit cards; MasterCard or VISA. After payment has been made, you will receive an internet receipt with confirmation that your entry has been received.

TITELS

To be qualified to participate in Tollermaster / Juniortollermaster the dog must be registered for BOTH Tollinghuntingtest and show (not in the class for disqualifying faults class).

Juniortollermaster

Is decided in the beginner class, and only dogs born in the previous two years, starting in exhibition <u>and</u> awards a prize from beginners class on TJP are eligible to participate in the fight for the award "Juniortollermaster of the Year".

Tollermaster

Decided in elite class. All dogs that go for a prize in the elite class are ranked and go on to Sunday's exhibition class and participates in the fight for the award "Tollermaster of the Year".

If you want to compete for the Junior or Tollermaster title, you MUST register the dog for both tollinghunting test and exhibition at the same time. (not in the disqualifying fault class)

Last day to enter is Monday 24/6 12.00 – OBSERVE THE TIME!

Paying classes for the exhibition are registered via SKK internet Entry Online.

In order to register via SKK internet Entry Online, membership in the organizing club is required, even foreign exhibitors must have membership in the Swedish toller club.

Dogs to be entered must be registered in a kennel organization approved by FCI. For foreign dogs, this means that the dog needs to also be in SKK's dog register.

If the dog is not in SKK's dog register, a copy of the registration certificate with pedigree must be sent to SKK, so they can enter the dog in their register. Once the dog is entered in the register, it is possible to enter for the Speciality.

The easiest way to do this is to scan your dog's original pedigree (which must have information about the dog's registered name, registration number, breed, birth number, lineage and breeder.) and e-mail it to reg@skk.se

You can also send a copy of the original pedigree by snail mail to SKK, at: Registreringsavdelningen, Box 771, SE 191 27 Sollentuna, Sweden.

You only need to state that you want to register your dog for exhibitions and competitions in Sweden.

Refund of registration fee

The registration fee for participation in the exhibition is not refunded due to change of judges. The registration fee is nor refunded in the case of an injured or sick dog, even on presentation of a veterinary certificate. The registration fee is nor refunded in the case of injured or sick owner, even on presentation of a medical certificate
